

Cohutta Springs Coronavirus Response

Welcome back to Cohutta Springs! We are looking forward to your upcoming stay with us. In response to the COVID-19 pandemic and updated government guidance, we have taken specific measures to assure our guests that their safety and health is our number one priority.

Prevention Measures

- Employees must wear a face mask at all times during their shift.
- Guests are encouraged to wear face masks and must maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet in public areas.
- Required health screenings for employees and guests upon arriving to the property. No one will be allowed to remain on the property if they have a cough, fever, or other symptoms.
- Special safety panels have been installed at the front desk, and the check in process has been modified to a contactless procedure.
- Seating in all dining and common areas has been re-arranged to follow social distancing guidelines.
- Visual aids for social distancing, hand washing, and other health practices have been implemented across campus.

Cleanliness Measures

- The property has been deep cleaned and sanitized prior to your arrival.
- Modified housekeeping operations, including changes to laundering and motel room cleaning processes.
- Increased sanitization frequency in high-traffic areas.
- Additional hand sanitizer stations throughout the main lodge and at food distribution areas.
- Guest rooms will remain vacant for a minimum of 24 hours in between guests.

Reducing Contact Measures

- Modified dining and serving operations designed to minimize touch points.
- For maintenance and housekeeping requests, motel rooms will be vacated by the guest while the requested task is completed.
- Touchless check-in and check-out procedures at the front desk.
